## Oncidium Orchid

Light: Bright, indirect light. Leaves should be bright green; reddish green leaves indicate too much light, dark green not enough light.

Care: Allow to moderately dry between waterings. Generally they require more water while the new shoot is growing and less once the bulb has formed. Take care to keep water out of new growth at base of plant. Fertilize once a month. Do not allow bottom of pot to stand in water. Do not use artificially softened water. Morning misting is helpful as oncidium enjoy 55-75% humidity with good air circulation and no cold drafts.
